Date: Saturday 1st December

Time: 3.00pm

Prizes: Cash prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd as follows:

1st \$400

2nd \$200

3rd \$100

No Santa's please, we already have one.

There will also be a \$100 participation prize which will be drawn at Moore Park from all who enter.

Assemble: Prior to 3.00pm in the Earl Industrial Area (opposite Caltex on the Main Rd.)
Assemble in areas designated by the Parade Marshal or his assistants.

Presentation: Prizes will be presented at Moore Park at 4.00pm approximately.

The Parade: Parade starts at 3.00pm.

Order of participants will be as directed by the Parade Marshal.

Note: The road will be closed for through traffic during the Parade.

Route: From the Earl industrial assembly area onto the Main Rd. (State Highway 2).
Proceed through the town and turn into the parking area at "The Talisman"
(please follow the directions of the Marshals).
Proceed along Talisman Drive, down the R.O.W beside the Memorial Hall, and turn left onto
the Main Rd., along the Main Rd., turning into Fairview Rd. Turn right onto Middlebrook Drive
and finish at Moore Park where floats can be parked, Marshals will direct, until dispersed.

Judging: This year the judges will view the entries before the parade and the results will be announced
with the prize winners given a "ribbon" to display during the parade. The judges' decision will
be final. Prizes will be presented at Moore Park at approximately 4pm.

Hazards:

- Gradual descent down the Main Rd. to “The Talisman”
- A number of large potholes in “The Talisman” carpark
- Confined area beside the Memorial Hall and pedestrians/spectators
- Spectators on both sides of the road
- Space for departure from the Parade of ambulance/fire brigade/police may be required
- Horses may be in the parade

Marshalls:

Please follow the instructions of the Marshalls throughout the Parade. They may be Katikati Lions-identified by gold vests and/or yellow caps, and/or Legion of Frontiersmen, who will be in uniform.

Parade Rules and Safety Requirements:

Each float/entry is responsible for ensuring public safety and the safety of those on /in their entry. The Lions Club of Katikati reserves the right to refuse entry prior to or on the day of the Parade.

All entries must comply with the Rules and Safety Requirements:

- Please stick to the designated parade order unless instructed to do otherwise
- OSH regulations require no throwing of lollies or giveaways or any other material from a parade entrant to spectators
- Give-aways, for example, balloons must be handed out by people walking alongside the entry and taken to the spectators
- All **missiles**, including water bombs and water guns are **forbidden**
- No burnouts, wheelies or reckless behavior. No high revving of engines (these activities may cause horses to panic and cause distress)
- Keep moving-keep up with the entry in front. Do not however exceed a slow walking pace (5 km per hour)
- Walking participants please keep outside the line of vehicles
- No alcohol or drugs
- *In the event of vehicle trouble please pull to the left-hand side of the road and await assistance*
- If an emergency vehicle is required, please pull to the left-hand side of the road to allow its passage
- Your vehicle must have a current WOF and registration and be driven by a driver licensed for the vehicle being driven
- Participants must adhere to road rules when travelling to or from the parade area
- There should be no movement of passengers on/off floats during the parade

- Any platforms including flat deck utes, trucks, trailers etc and/or seats or similar must be secure and be provided with hand rails to ensure the safety of those on the platform
- People on the float, particularly children, must be under competent supervision
- Participants must provide their own insurance. (We recommend that you inform your insurance company that your vehicle is being used for a purpose other than normal, to ensure that your insurance cover is not compromised)
- The Lions Club of Katikati (club members and members of their families), takes no responsibility for the participant's entry or personnel, nor for any damage caused by participants
- Vehicles which are driven, and have the capacity, should have a driver and a passenger in the cab.
- Towards the end of the parade route, from Main Rd. down Fairview Rd to Moore Park, please do not sound sirens, horns or make any other loud noises as these may startle livestock in adjacent paddocks.

First Aid: Available beside the museum. There will be a First Aid Station at Moore Park.
